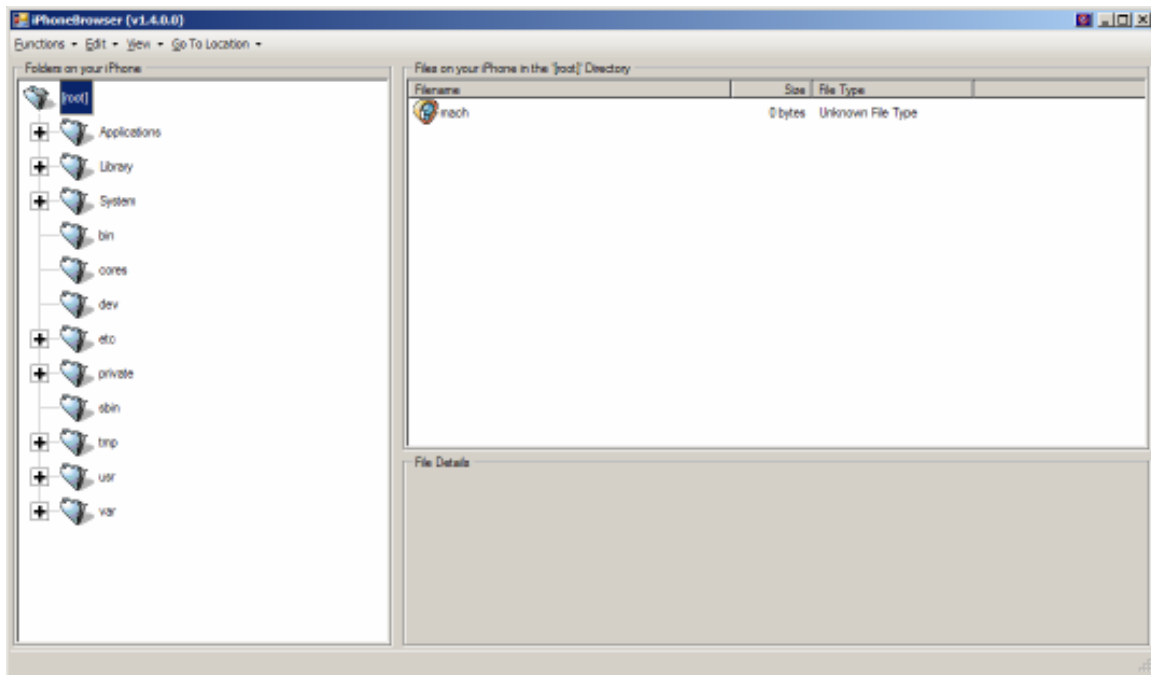


## Changing Your Carrier Logo Using iPhoneBrowser

This tutorial will walk you through changing your carrier logo using iPhonebrowser. This tutorial assumes a few things:

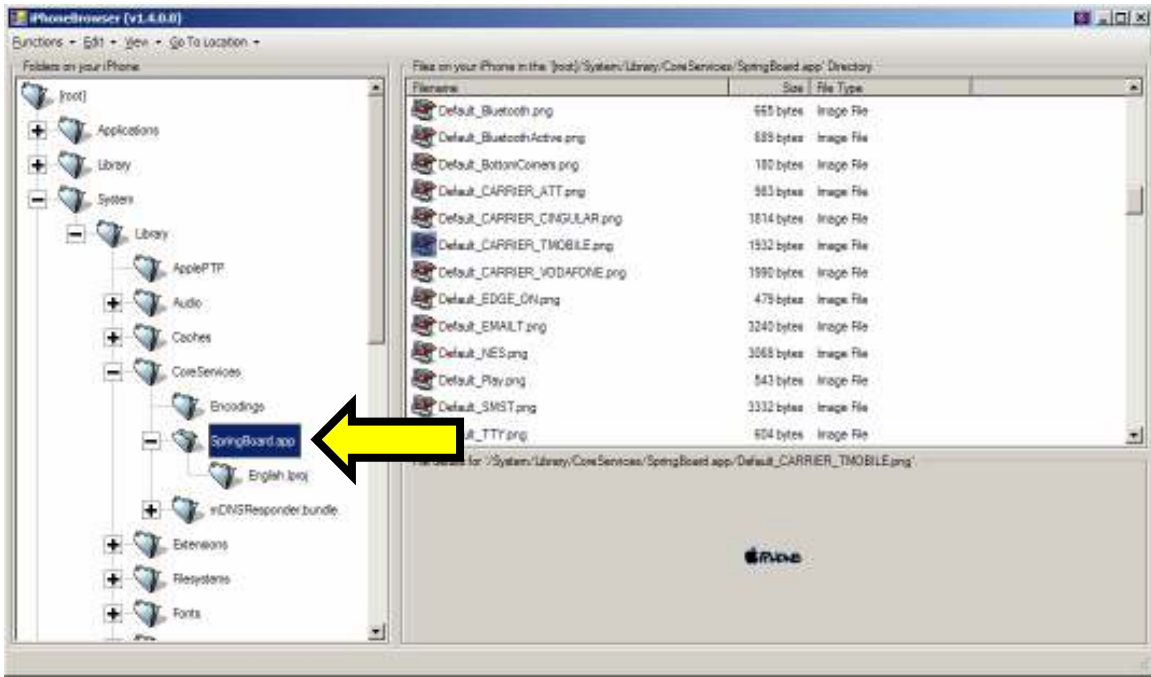
- Your carrier is either Tmobile, ATT, Cingular, Vodaphone.
- You have downloaded and installed iPhonebrowser
  - <http://code.google.com/p/iphonebrowser/>
- You're using Windows
- The image you want to use for your carrier logo fits the standard logo dimensions
  - 65x20 pixels
  - I believe the optimal resolution is 300 pixels/inch
    - Don't quote me on those dimensions but it's always worked for me.
    - The image file must be .png file.

Let's get started.....plug your phone into your computer and launch iPhonebrowser. Once you're connected you get this screen.



Navigate (click on the folders) to the following directory:

- System
  - Library
    - CoreServices
      - Springboard.app (everything is done in this folder)

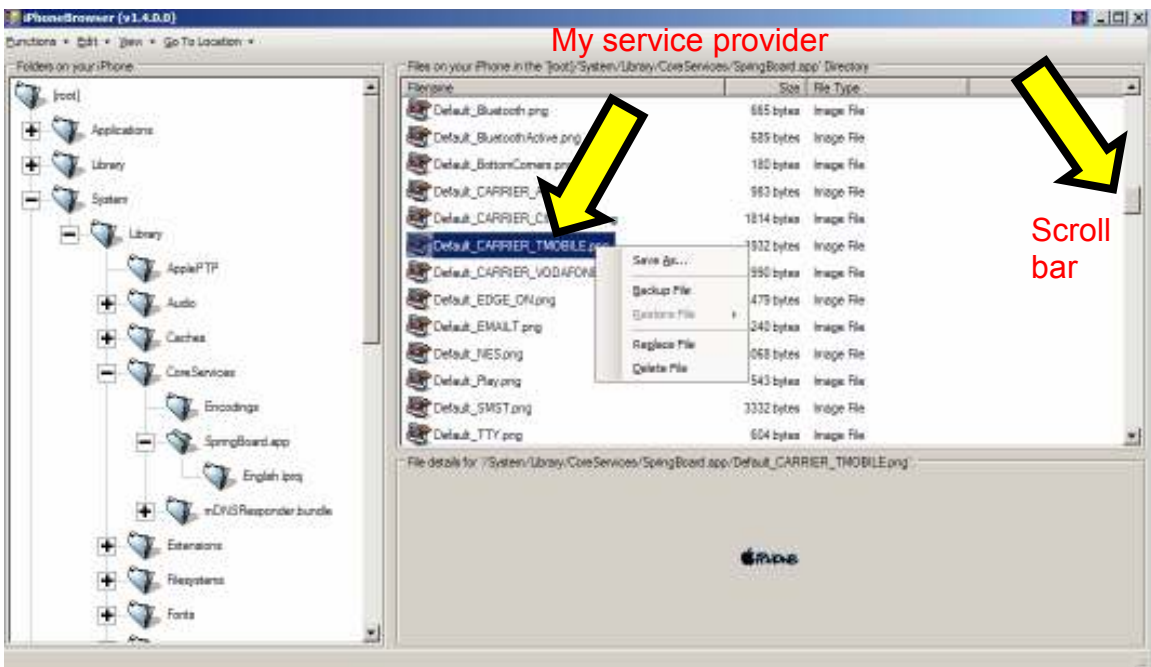


Use the scroll bar and scroll down until you see the file 'Default\_CARRIER\_YOUR CARRIER'

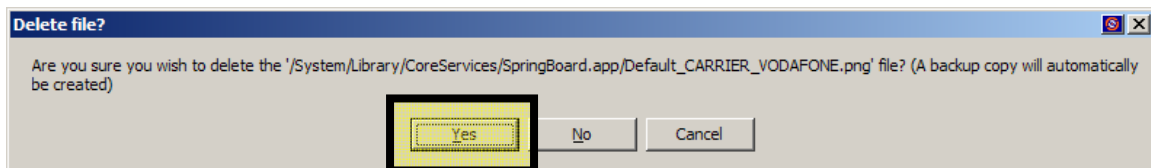
- **YOUR CARRIER** = Whomever your service provider is
  - Example : If your provider is TMobile you would look for the file called: **Default\_CARRIER\_TMOBILE**
  - If your carrier is ATT you would look for the file called **Default\_CARRIER\_ATT**

Right click on the file and choose :

- Delete File

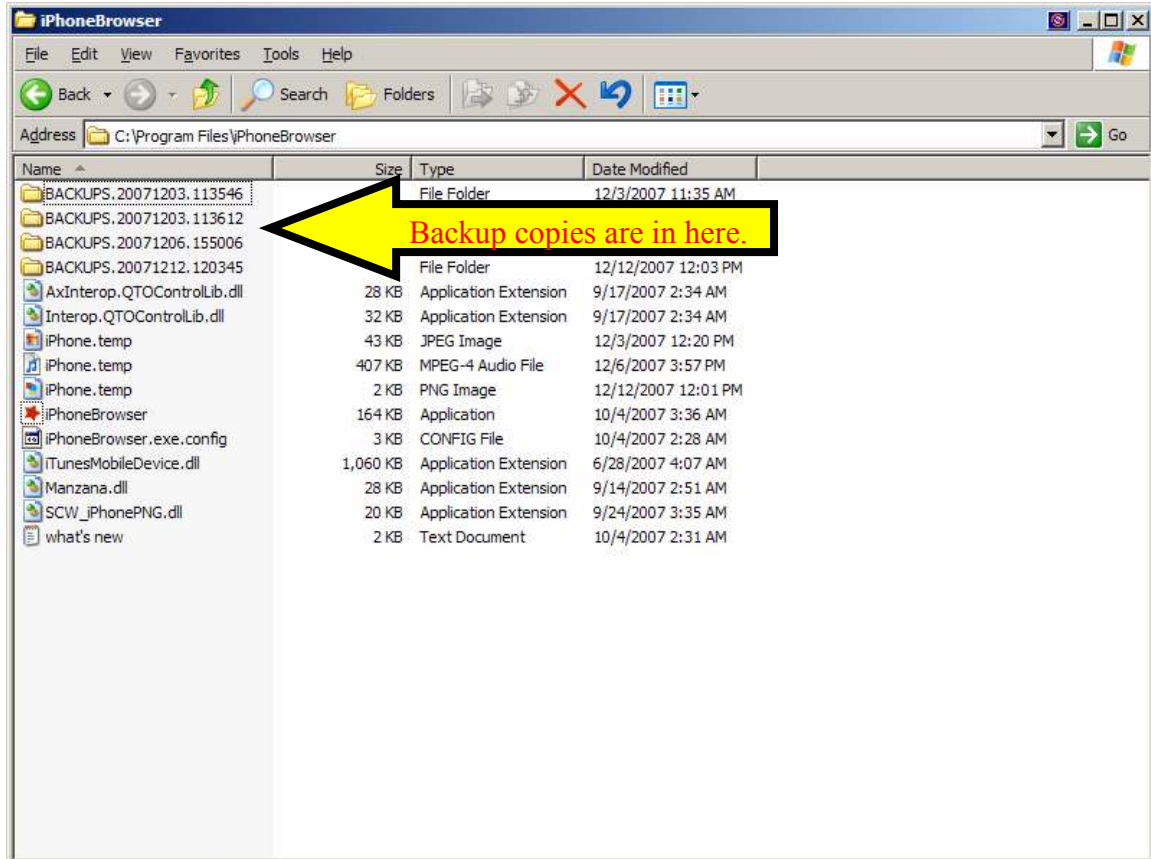


When you choose 'Delete File' you will get this prompt:



Click Yes.

This prompt is just making sure you want to delete this file. A backup copy will be saved in your iPhonebrowser folder.

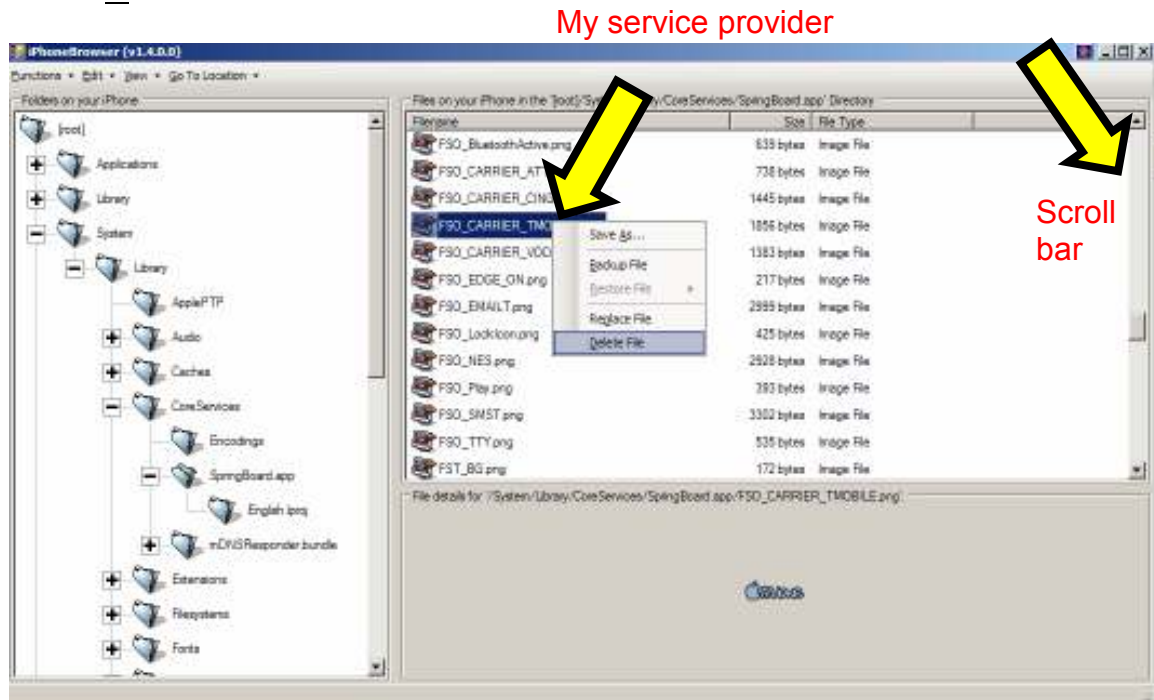


Now use the scroll bar and scroll down until you see the file 'FSO\_CARRIER\_YOUR CARRIER'

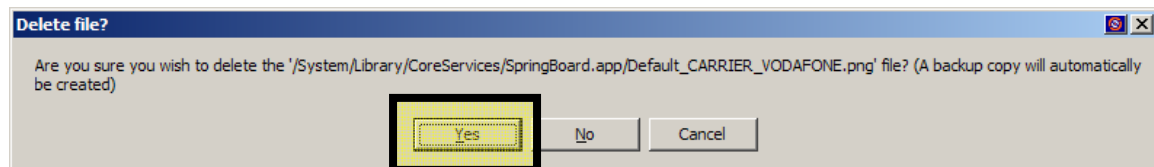
- **YOUR CARRIER** = Whomever your service provider is
  - Example : If your provider is TMobile you would look for the file called:  
**FSO\_CARRIER\_TMOBILE**
  - If your carrier is ATT you would look for the file called  
**FSO\_CARRIER\_ATT**

Right click on the file and choose :

- Delate File



When you choose 'Delete File' you will get this prompt:



Click Yes. Again, a backup will be saved in the backups folder.

Now you've deleted and backed up your existing carrier logos.

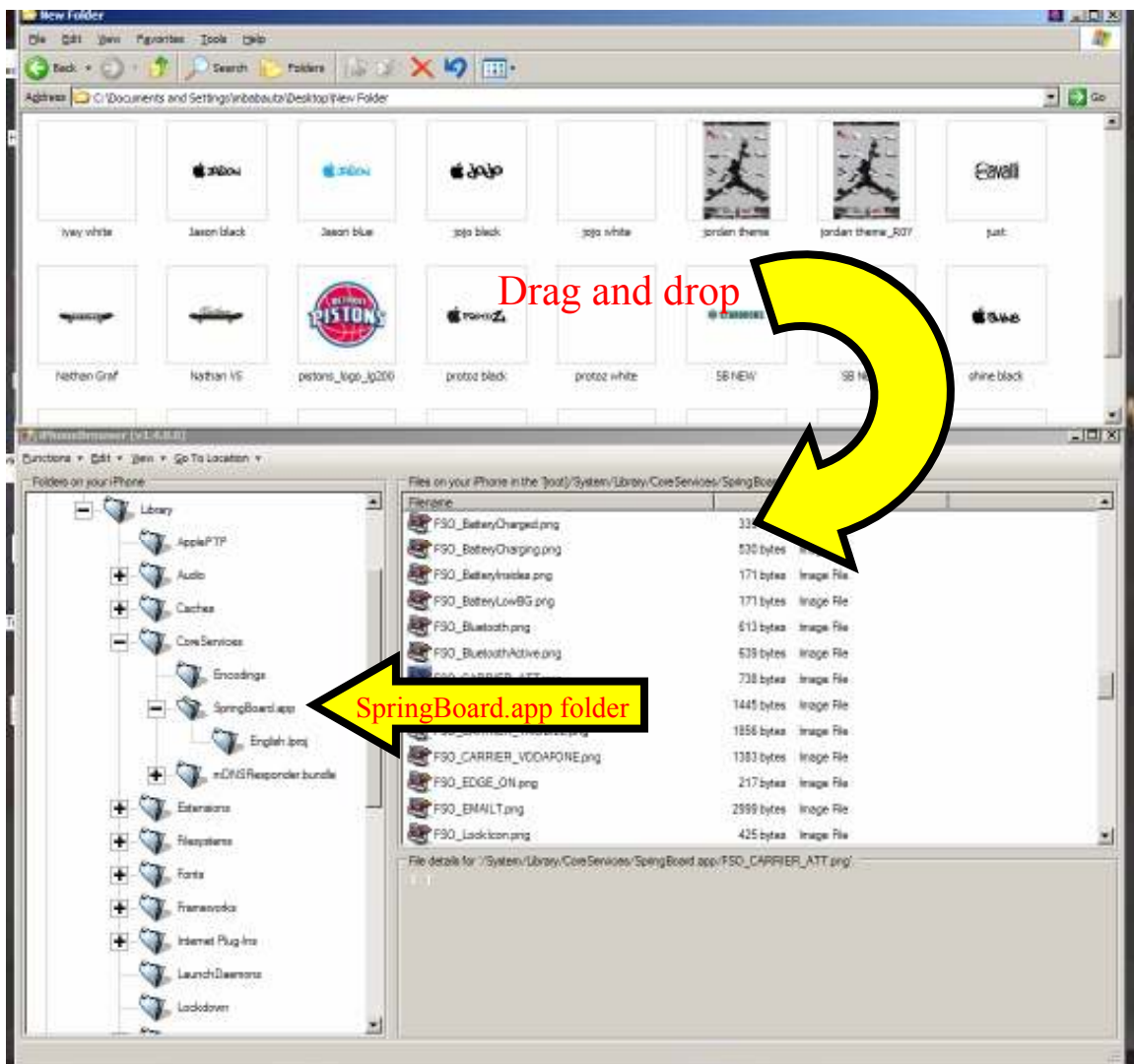
Before you add your new carrier logo you must rename them. Things to remember when renaming your new carrier logos:

- There are two of them:

- **FSO\_CARRIER\_YOUR\_CARRIER**  
Example : If your provider is TMobile your file should be named:  
**FSO\_CARRIER\_TMOBILE**
- **Default\_CARRIER\_YOUR\_CARRIER**  
Example : If your provider is TMobile your file should be named:  
**Default\_CARRIER\_TMOBILE**

- Note the capitalization. It has to be exact.
- Note the underscores. It has to be exact.
- The FSO file is the light colored one.
- The Default file is the dark colored one.

Now that you have your files named properly you can simply drag and drop your new carrier logos into iPhonebrowser in the same folder you deleted the original carrier logos.



That's all there is to it. If you're using a carrier other than the ones listed in the Springboard.app folder (TMobile, Cingular, ATT, Vodaphone) I'm not sure how to change that. Ask at [www.modmyifone.com](http://www.modmyifone.com) if you have any questions.
